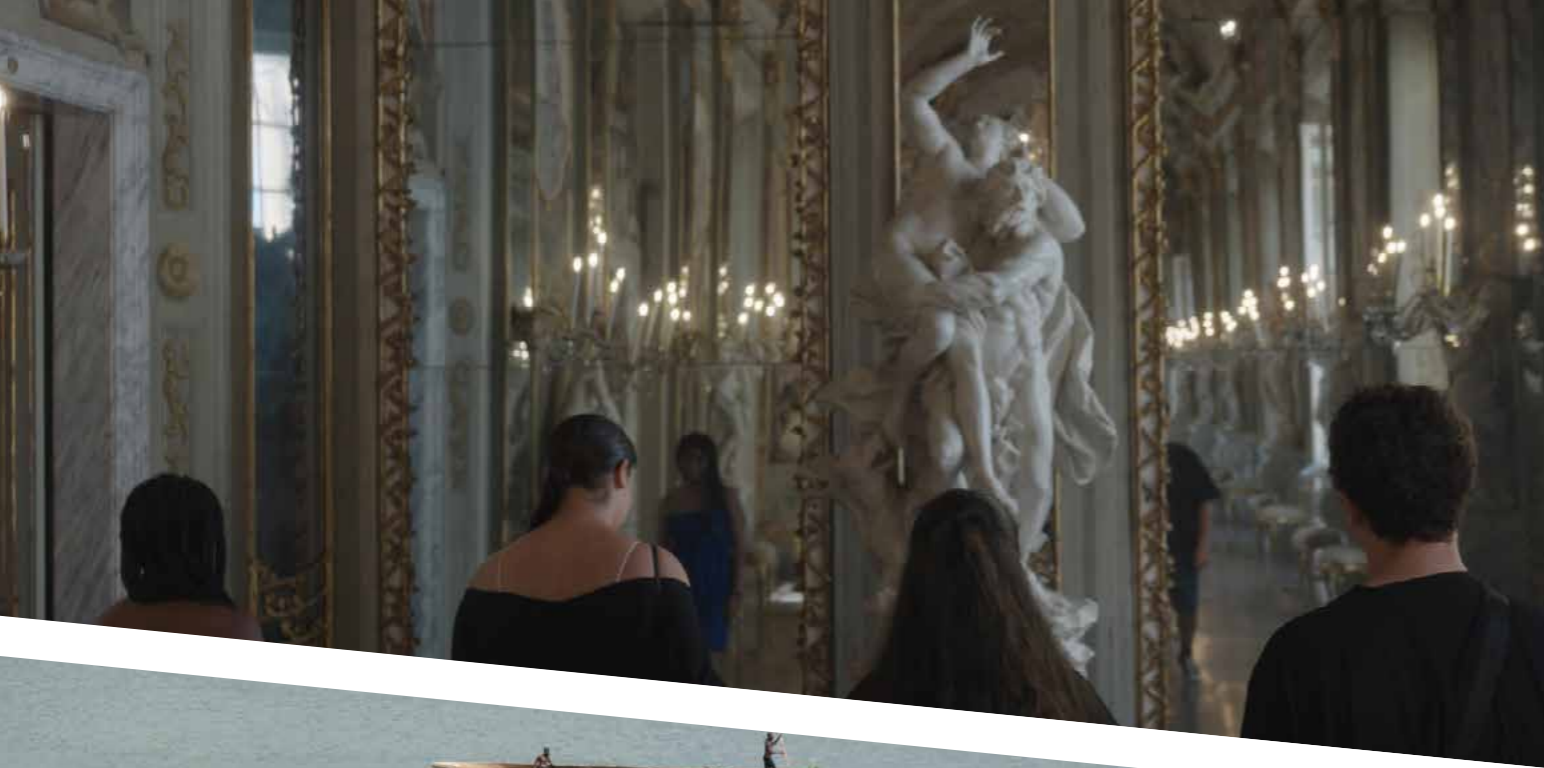

Organ trading, one of the most sinister and disturbing activities that have infiltrated Iraqi society, operates through an underground market, readily accessible via social media platforms, enabled in part by the complicity of government officials. It's there that organized crime connects supply and demand of human organs (a big part represented by kidneys), extending far beyond Iraq's borders. Brokers and doctors facilitate these transactions, with each kidney transplant generating tens of thousands of euros in revenue, while the donors themselves are left with a few thousand euros and irreversible health damage. This predicament is the culmination of two decades of civil war, sectarian conflict between Shiites and Sunnis, and corruption at the highest levels of government, that have left the nation in a state of deep poverty. In this situation, compounded by a dramatic level of water pollution due to the constant violation of environmental laws, not many Iraqis can afford to buy bottled water and food grown with 'safe' water. As a consequence, the number of people with kidney disease in Iraq is seriously increasing, and the local public health system is unable to meet this growing demand for healthy kidneys, leaving room for the black market. On the other side of the fence, this demand to be filled represents an unhoped-for opportunity for all those living on the poverty line, never mind at the cost of their own health. The documentary reveals this chilling truth through the personal stories of the main protagonists of Iraq's organ trafficking trade, as well as political analysts and organ trafficking experts, providing insight into a complex world where the line between right and wrong is often blurry and faint.

For decades, the Ottawa Treaty stood as a global commitment to ban anti-personnel landmines—an agreement rooted in humanitarian principles and civilian protection. By April, Latvia had voted to withdraw from the Treaty, and other countries bordering Russia are now openly debating

PUTIN'S SHADOWS ON AFRICA THE CENTRAL AFRICAN REPUBLIC MODEL

The Battle of the Metaurus, fought in 207

BC, stopped that reunion and changed the course of history. Yet the exact location of this decisive clash has remained a mystery for centuries. Today, Italian and Spanish archaeologists are searching the landscapes of central Italy for traces of the lost battlefield, combining ancient sources, battlefield archaeology and modern technology in an attempt to rediscover the place where Rome was saved.



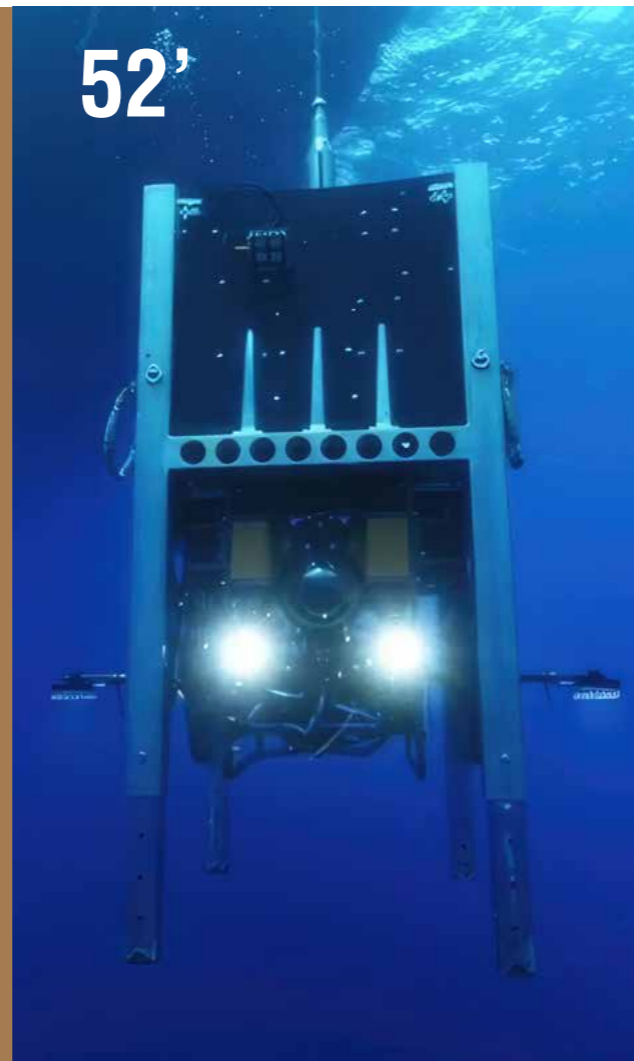

VITRUM ROME'S GLASS REVOLUTION



In 2013, Italian engineer Guido Gay discovered an ancient shipwreck between Corsica and Italy at a depth of 360 meters. While the cargo was initially thought to be ballast stone, it soon became clear that the ship was delivering tonnes of glass in varying degrees of workmanship. This remarkable discovery, the second of its kind, prompts the formation of a Franco-Italian archaeological team to investigate the wreck's cargo, now known as the Capo Corso 2, onboard the Alfred Merlin. This film explores the significance of glass in Ancient Rome through the team's deep-sea archaeological research, and how the development and dissemination of glassmaking methods changed human civilisation forever.

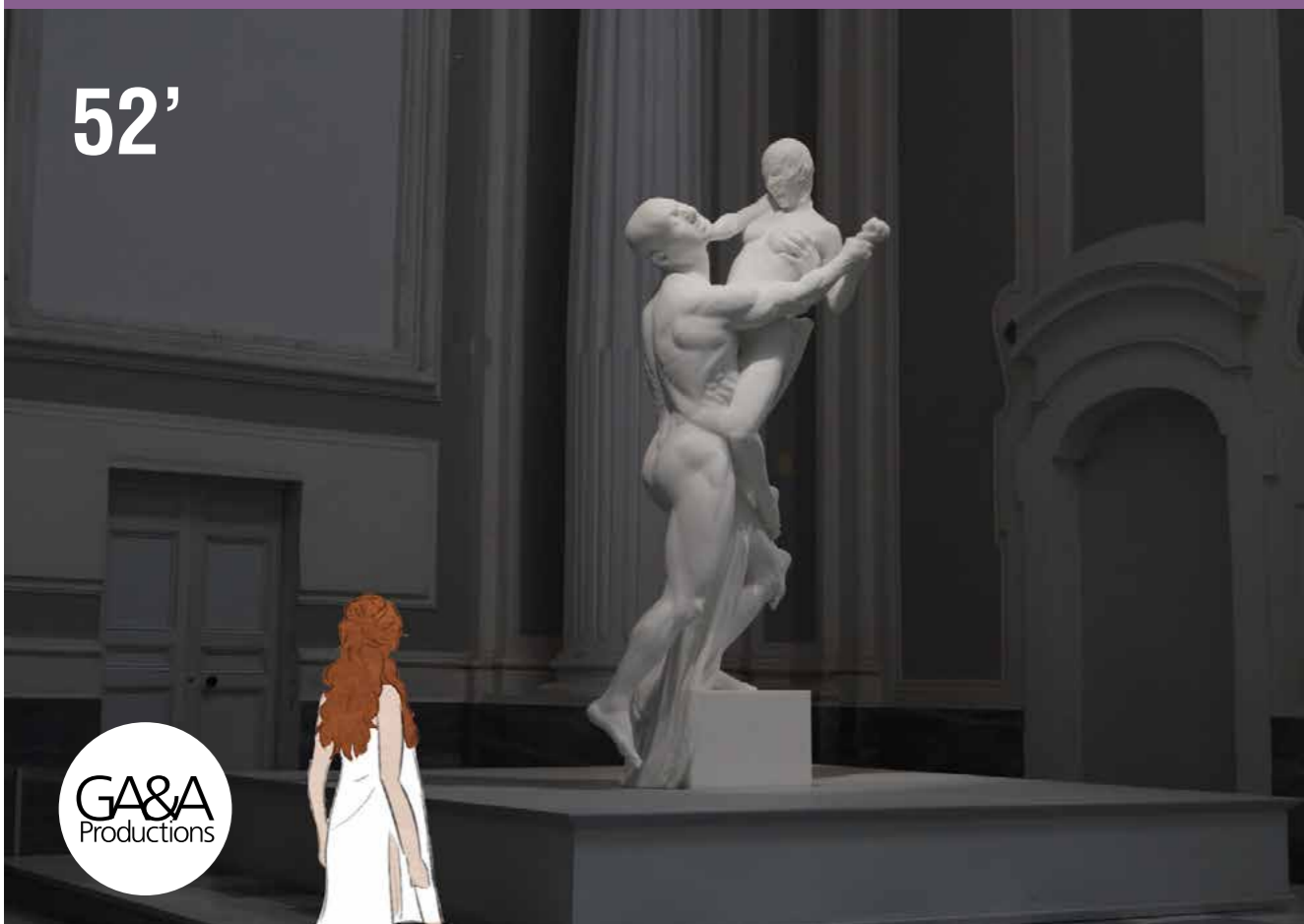

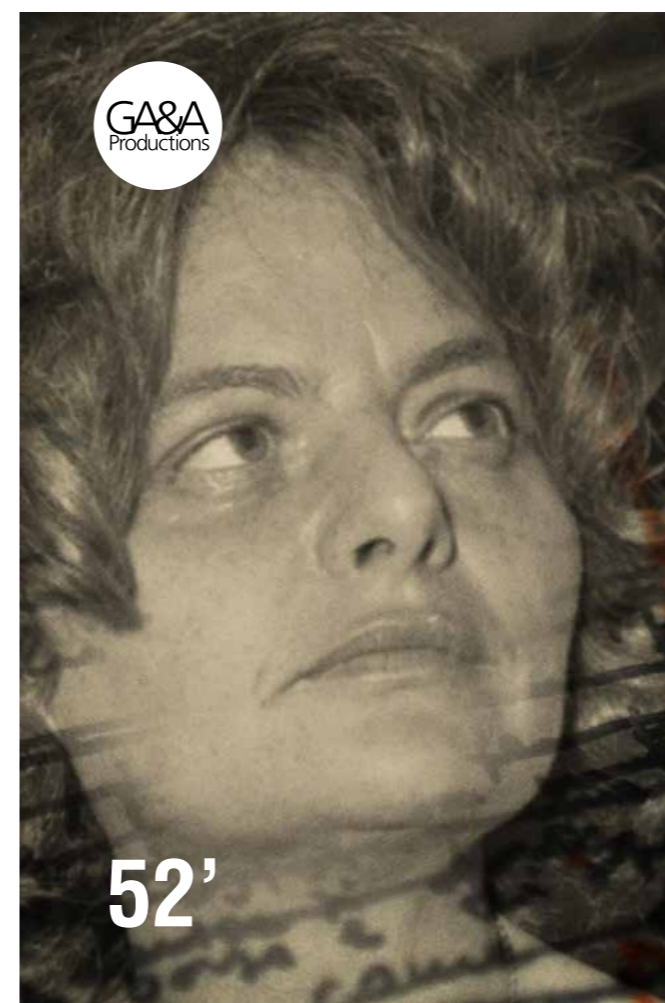

Neither disenchanted nor bitter, he simply seemed to say when he appeared in town and on the screen that life is not so serious – or else was too much so – not to have fun. What character is hidden behind the docile and indolent actor? Who is the man who has never stopped fighting, in vain, against the image of a Latin-lover that the whole world has stuck on his forehead? Who is hiding under the make-up and the game of the actor Marcello Mastroianni? Is he really what he claims to be?



LA STORIA

THE SCANDAL NOVEL



In the summer of 1974, Elsa Morante’s novel La Storia caused a cultural and political debate the world over that lasted more than a year. This was due to both Morante’s choice to sacrifice a portion of her royalties to make it universally accessible, and the scandalous nature of Ida’s story, carrying the traumatic reminder of her rape by a German soldier inside her as she falls pregnant.
